In pursuance to approval from the GM/HQ, WBFDCL, his good Office memo no. 1225/IT-229/2021 dated 28.06.2023, a sealed Tender for felling and disposal of 8 (Eight) numbers of standing Trees leaning towards Maternity & Child building, Bishnupur District Hospital, Bishnupur, Bankura is going to be held on 17th July, 2023 as per the scheduled Terms and Conditions specified below. The sealed Tenders are invited from the eligible persons/ agencies/ companies, including consortium and partnership firms for purchasing of those 8 (Eight) numbers of standing Trees and to dispose off the felled Trees as soon as possible from the felling site.

The intending Tenderers are hereby informed that the quotations in sealed cover should be addressed by name to "Shri Dibyajyoti Bera, W.B.F.S., the Divisional Manager, Bankura Forest Corporation Division" and the sealed Tenders will be receiving during working hours from 17.07.2023 to 21.07.2023 by Post, Courier or by hand and will be opened on the next working day 24.07.2023 at 11:00 am. The bidders are requested to be present during opening of the sealed Tender. The necessary Tender documents will be available from the website. TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR TENDER SALE STANDING TREES:

1. The Tender forms along with Terms and Conditions of Tender will be available from 17.07.2023 to 28.07.2023 between 11.00 am. to 05.00 pm, from the Office of the Divisional Manager, Bankura Forest Corporation Division.
2. For participating in Tender, all intending bidders shall be required to deposit a sum of Rs. 1685/- (Rupees One Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Five Only) as Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) by Bank Draft only, drawn on any nationalized Bank payable at Bankura in favour of "Divisional Manager, Bankura Forest Corporation Division, WBFDCL," at the time of dropping the Tender along with sealed Tender paper of quoted rates.
3. Under no circumstances, the EMD will be adjusted with the Sale value of any purchased standing Trees.
4. An intending purchaser, desirous to participate in the sealed Tender with the WBFDCL need to submit self-attested copy of a valid PAN. In addition, the intending purchasers must provide self-attested copy of GSTIN registration number wherever applicable.
5. An intending purchaser should also have a valid mobile number and e-mail ID which should be mentioned during submission of the sealed Tender.
6. If the documents furnished, as mentioned under clause no 4 above, are proved to be materially false, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in Tender process and the Tenderers may also be liable to be debarred from participation in any future sealed Tenders to be conducted by WBFDCL. Apart from the above actions, the EMD Rs. 1685/- (Rupees One Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Five Only) deposited by the purchaser as per clause 2 above, shall also be forfeited to the WBFDCL and appropriate legal action may be initiated against the said purchaser.
7. Intending tenderer should produce credentials of similar nature of work.
8. The successful Tenderer will have to start the work as per the work order to commence the work.
9. Prevailing safety norms and adequate safety measures have to be followed by the successful Tenderer during execution of the work so that we can avoid any untoward incident.
10. The eligibility of a Tenderer will be ascertained on the basis of the documents submitted by a Tenderer in support of eligibility criteria. If any document submitted by a Tenderer is found to be incomplete/incorrect/ manufactured / fabricated or false, his Tender will be out rightly rejected at any stage and legal action will be taken against him.
11. A Tenderer is to quote in figures as well as in words, his rates in the following forms as applicable in his cases against the estimated value put to tender of the tender form (BOQ).
12. The Tenderer must sign at the bottom of each page of the tender documents as a proof of acceptance of terms and conditions of the Tender. Overwriting shall not be allowed. All corrections, alternations etc. must be duly signed.

13. It must be clearly understood that the quantities of the various items indicated in the schedule or probable items are approximate only and may be appreciably increased or decreased during actual execution. The contractor shall remain effected by alteration.
14. All bids are inclusive of all statutory Taxes and other levies as may be applicable under the Law. No amount will be accepted unless all statutory Taxes and other levies, as chargeable, are paid along with the Sale values.
15. Bids submitted by the purchaser can be above/ less/ equal to estimated value against each standing Trees. However, only highest bids against each standing Trees will be accepted by the Tender inviting Authority.
16. No consideration will be made for any bid made inadvertently or by miscalculation or through typing error. The intending purchasers should be careful while submitting a bid.
17. The bidder of the highest bid, on closure of the Tender process at the scheduled date and time, will get intimation about acceptance of his bid, through e-mail / Post.
18. In case of no communication for acceptance of a highest bid, the bid should be treated as rejected.
19. The date of confirmation/acceptance of Sale shall be reckoned as date of communication to the bidder for all purposes.
20. The Work Order will be issued by the Tender accepting Authority or by any officer authorized by him only on payment of full sale value. Certificate of Origin of the felled produce will be issued for obtaining Transit Pass by the concerned unit in charge.
21. All taxes as applicable at the rates in force at the material time of sale shall have to be paid by the purchaser at the time of depositing sale value in addition to the sale of the produce as quoted by the purchaser.
22. During the period of extraction of the produce, sold in the Tender, the purchaser shall have to abide by the provisions of the Indian Forest Act 1927 and the West Bengal Forest Produce Transit Rules, 1959 and amendments there-under. Failure to comply with the provisions of the said Act and the Rules shall make the purchaser liable to penal action as provided therein.
23. Stumps uprooting is not included in the scope of work. After harvesting and disposal of Trees from the location, the uprooting of stump will be done by the purchaser.
24. If the felling site is not free from the encumbrances such as habitations area, then the matter shall be communicated to the undersigned well in advance at least 15 days before so that the necessary intimation shall be communicated to the Hospital Authority as well as local administration for necessary arrangement.
25. The utmost care and safety measures have to be taken by the contractor during felling operation so as to avoid any loss to the property and life. Any damage if so occur, must be compensated from your own fund. The contractor will be responsible for loss/damage to property and life because of negligence of driver of poor maintenance of vehicle or due to an accident. WBFDCCL would not be responsible of loss /damage to property or life on account of such incident.

26. The Terms and Conditions of the Sale mentioned herein above shall be deemed to be a part of the Agreement itself which shall have to be agreed by the Tenderer after confirmation of Sale of the standing Trees and shall be binding on the parties.

27. In case of any dispute on the decision of the General Manager, (HQ), WBFDCL shall be final and binding upon the purchaser.
